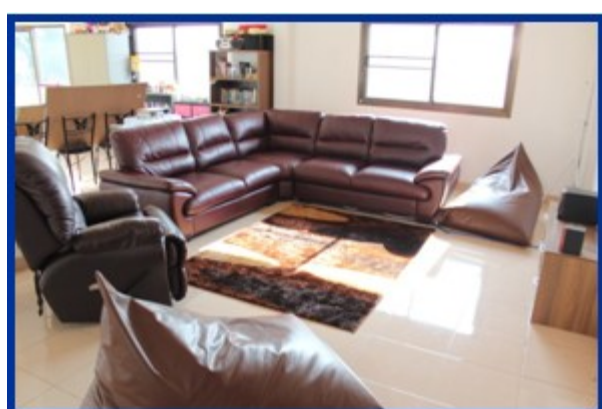


This month, we are thankful for so many things in our life.
