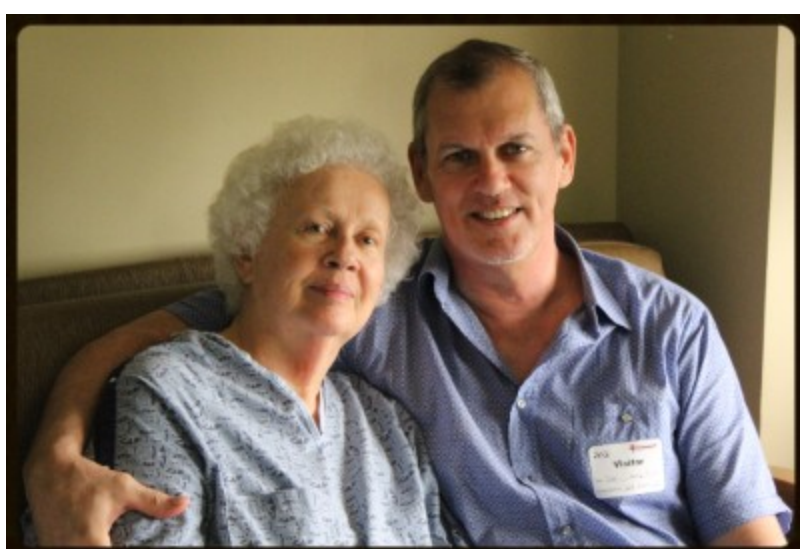

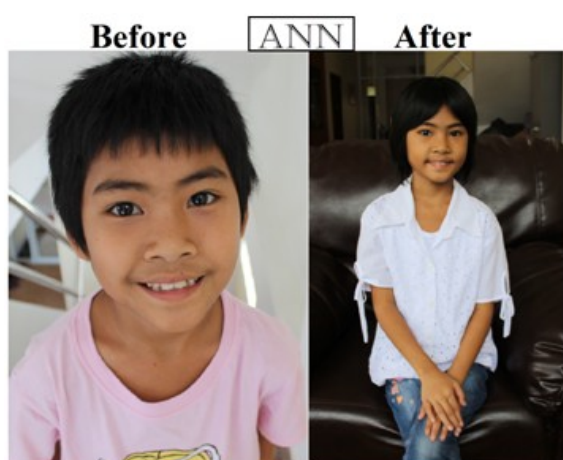
The children

They can also read and write basic words and are as bold as ever when it comes to laying hands on and praying for someone's healing. Nadia (13) and Ann (8), who have been with us for only 5 months now, can say and understand several English sentences and can say the alphabet and count, all of which they could not do before.



We did not notice the changes in their physical appearance until we saw pictures of how they used to look when we first brought them into our home. With the healthy diet they've been eating, they all have grown so much and are stronger than ever. David, who was malnourished and had sores covering his body, is now completely healthy and proud to show that he can do 50 pushups.

We are currently in the rainy season here and it is difficult for us to travel. Our truck seats five inside and letting three kids sit in the very back (which they allow here in Thailand), is no longer an option because they will get soaked from the rain. We must sit in each other's laps whenever we have family outings such as going to the park or to the store; it is very crowded and uncomfortable and is only possible for short trips. We are praying and believing for a van and we know God will provide. We ask, that if God has put it in your heart, to kindly give toward a van.
