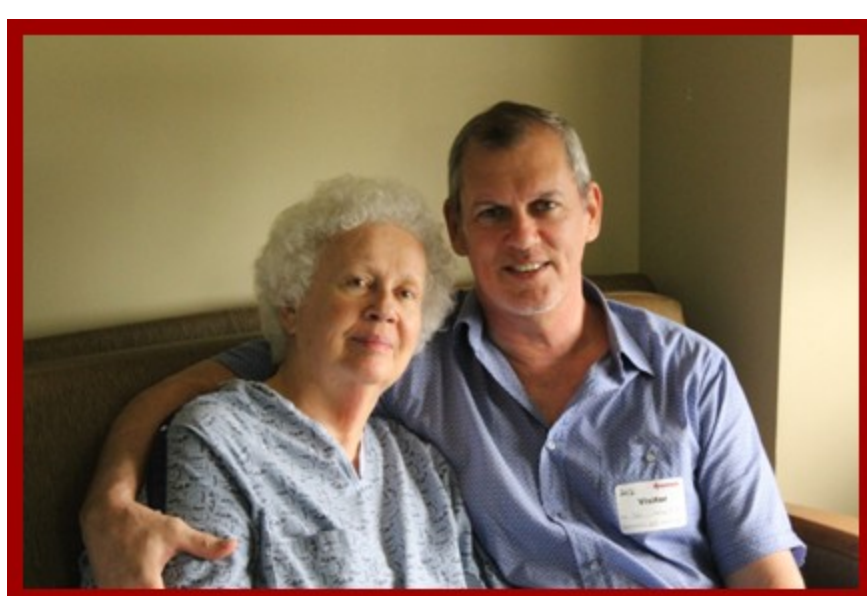

I want to say thank you to all our friends and partners that prayed for her healing. We praise God that all went well.

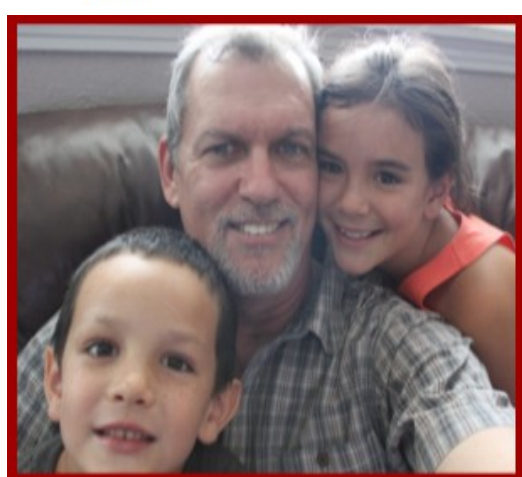
