I am happy to announce that I completed 10th grade this month. Ariya and I are very pleased with our school as it is challenging and insightful as it teaches us from a Christian standpoint. This is our third year using the home school curriculum and we plan to use it until we graduate. The setup allows us to create our own yearly school plan which works perfectly for us as we need flexibility to be able to do outreaches and assist in teaching the children during the week. We have the need for finances that will provide for our next school year's curriculum and we know that God will provide as He always has. Our need for the Christian curriculum for our four children, Ariya and I is \$2,650. If God puts on your heart to help toward this need, we thank you. This amount will be providing for six students at five different levels. This will not only cover the curriculum, but all school supplies as well.

We have grown very close to the families at the church near us. We have started a bible study every Friday night; we simply discuss the Bible together.



Everyone there is welcome to share their opinion and ideas on the subject and our oldest boy David, is always eager to point out a scripture that relates to the subject. Though he is only 11 years old, he has a great understanding of the Word.

Also this month, Ariya and I have been traveling back and forth to our grandparent's home about a five hour drive away. The first trip, we went for nearly a week to paint the inside of their house as it needed it badly. The second time, only Ariya and Mew went for six days to be with our grandfather during his second cataracts surgery. He is recovering well and can now see clearly.



It has been raining everyday here and the part of the country that we are in is prone to vicious winds. Our new garden behind the house has been holding up fairly well with only slight damage. We were able to repair it and nothing major was lost. When we are able to move and expand, we plan to build a stronger structure. This garden has been somewhat of a test as our initial plan is to have a large scale aquaponics system that will completely provide for all of the Homes of Hope in the future as well as generate some income.
