This month, Arisa and I, along with the kids have progressed greatly with our school work. Me and my sister are expecting to finish 10th grade in March. I thank God for the strength to be diligent in my school work and for the capability of being self-taught.



Our kids are progressing also. The boys are able to memorize scriptures in both English and Thai; not only can they remember them, but they understand the *meaning* of the verses as well. They have come a very long way from when they first came into our family; both of them can have all English conversations with us now.

Nadia and Ann are improving as well. They understand a lot of things we say to them in English. As it is with learning new languages, they understand more than they can speak; but soon they will be able to speak in English too.



We take turns teaching them every day with the School of Tomorrow curriculum. When education is the goal, time is not a factor. Every kid learns at a different pace; so we do not rush the kids to learn in a restricted period of time. This helps us fully develop the building blocks in their minds so that they may completely grasp and comprehend the subject; be it English, math, Thai, etc.

Next week we're looking forward to doing some school outreaches and participating in a youth group ministry concert that we have been invited to. We will tell you more about it in next month's newsletter.

I want to thank all of our partners who are a part of our ministry and what we are doing to help this nation. Also, I'd like to thank everyone for the contributions towards buying a van for our family. The vans we are looking at are made by Toyota, and are not available in the US; so they look slightly different from vans we are used to seeing in America. These



Asian vans ride higher than a car, so we won't have the same problems with the rural roads as we did with our old car before we purchased the truck. Also, these vans can seat 16 passengers which will not only be enough for our family, but will also be able to seat more children in the future or even small mission teams that come to visit. We still lack about \$37,000, and we are trusting God for his provision.
